Onyx stones= preciousness 1 Pet.2:5

ephod = worn upon shoulders

breastplate= worn over the heart

Rev.11:17-19 Intro to the day of atonement:

MOST HOLY PLACE: DAY OF ATONEMENT

Revelation 11:19 Introduces us into the most holy place, hence the day of atonement.

Revelation 12-14 is the plain explanation of the great controversy. This is the crime scene unfolding before our eyes! The evidence!! The books are opened and insight is gained as to the nature of the judgment, the commandments of God, the blood of the lamb, the three angels messages, These are the chapters, the books that are opened up to our understanding.

Revelation 15-18 (the seven plagues) depict the judgment of those cut off at the end of the antitypical day of atonement.

Revelation 19:11 The punishment of those cut off. Jesus coming out of the Sanctuary

Revelation 20 is the depiction of Azazel. Jesus just before he leaves the most holy place places sins upon the scapegoat. Satan is sent into the wilderness for 1000 years.
